# SURVIVAL PACK RECOMMENDATION

## ACCOMMODATIONS

### SILKWOOD RESIDENCE

- 8-10 minute walk, 750 meters
- 4-6 million/month
- Pros
  - Close distance even compared to Pacific Garden
  - It has many tenants (food, laundry, etc) & stores making the atmosphere lively for students
  - The facilities inside are complete for a general apartment residence
  - A big single-bedroom unit that's cheaper than the other single-bedroom and studio apartment alternatives.
- Cons
  - Tend to be crowded so they should move quickly if they'd like to rent for the study semester
  - It's quite old and some of the facilities are quite lacking. It's also much more expensive than a "Kos"

### PACIFIC GARDEN

- 5-8 minute walk, ~500 meters
- 3-6 million/month
- Pros
  - The closest distance to the campus so it's more time efficient for students. They don't have to rush in the morning
  - It's a new apartment complex so they're actively recruiting tenants. Their agents will be quick in handling the rent agreement and will help them thoroughly
  - It has Starbucks at the lower ground floor for students to work or study. And other food tenants making it more efficient for those who want a quick meal
  - Mall Alam Sutera is right at the opposite for those who want to shop, entertainment or go to the gym.

- Cons
  - Less tenants may create an eerie feeling for students, making them uncomfortable
  - The studio room is considerably small, may be suffocating for students
  - The view isn't extravagant considering there's only empty lands surrounding the apartment.

### ZEAL RESIDENCE

- 10 minutes by car, 2 km
- 3-7 million/month
- Pros
  - Complete facility (AC, bathroom inside your room, free wifi, warm water, pantry including microwave), a small cafe nearby, a laundry nearby to wash your clothes, cleaning service to clean your bathroom every week.
- Cons
  - No kitchen inside your room so if you want to cook you have to go to the pantry (which can be impractical)
  - Too far to go on foot to the campus
  - Small and cramped room



# SURVIVAL PACK RECOMMENDATION

## ACCOMODATIONS

### BROOKLYN APARTMENT

- 5-10 minutes by car, 2-3 km
- 4-5 million/month
- Pros
  - Pretty near the campus, there are cafes & minimarkets, lots of food option, and near the Living World Mall
  - Comfy and exclusive enviroment
- Cons
  - A bit pricey
  - Too far to go on foot to the campus

### PADDINGTON HEIGHTS

- 5 minutes by car or 8 - 15 minute walk, 850m
- 4 - 9 million/month (Typical Studio Room)
- Pros
  - Close to Campus
  - Private and secure
  - Free Parking (with access card)
  - Complete with swimming pool, sizeable gym, with laundry service on the first floor
  - Filled with mostly students, quiet environment
- Cons
  - Nearest convinience store is across the street, none on the first floor
  - Depending on the unit, prices can get a bit pricey.
  - Not all rooms are similar, some might include stoves, some might not.

### ADITANA RESIDENCE (KOS)

- 5 minutes by car or 10 minute walk, ~1.5 km
- 2.7-3.5 million/month
- Pros
  - Cheaper compared to the rest of the choices
  - Has complete facilities and wide extra space in the room considering the price
  - Has a variety of food and snack choices surrounding the area.

- Cons
  - The furthest from campus and traffic may happen since it's close to BINUS
  - Less rooms compared to apartment residence so they must be quick in renting
  - The access towards it is a small road which may be a hassle for some.

### IN ALAM SUTER CLUSTERS HARMONI, NARADA, ETC (KOS)

- 10-15 mins drive by car
- 1.8-2.8 million/month
- Pro
  - Electricity, wifi, water, all provided. No need to pay extra like an apartment.
- Cons
  - Too far to go on foot to the campus
  - A bit far to go on foot to market, mall and food places



# SURVIVAL PACK RECOMMENDATION

## ACCOMODATIONS

### SPRINGWOOD RESIDENCE

- 8 minutes by car, ~2 km
- 3-5 million/month
- Pros
  - Many students live nearby
  - Price for rent including maintenance and facility fees
  - Recommended for those that don't have vehicles to go to campus
  - There are nearby laundry and minimarkets such as Indomaret, Lawson, Alfamart
- Cons
  - The building is old and the facility such as the pool and the gym are very tiny

### GRAHA RAYA (KOS)

- 10-15 minutes by car, 5 km
- 600k - 2 million/month
- Pros
  - Cheaper option compared to apartments
- Cons
  - Not within walking distance

### NORTH PANUNGGANGAN

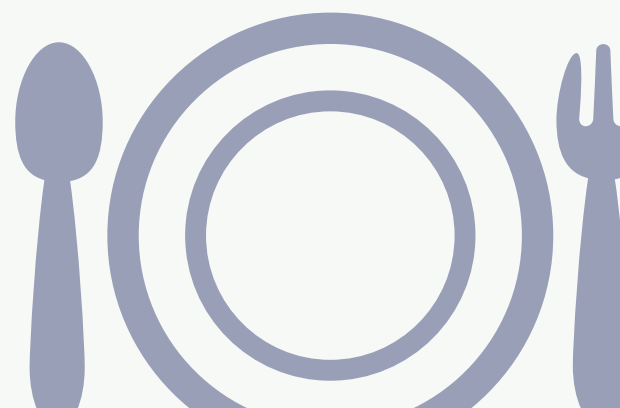
- 15 minute walk, ~1 km
- 1.5-2.5 million/month
- Pros
  - There's a lot of food stalls and they're quite cheaply priced. Overall the community is friendly as long as you're respectful
- Cons
  - The area will be a bit inconvenience (countrified)
  - Not very clean.

Pasar Delapan	20k - 70k	Various food (rice, local food, chicken, etc.)
UBM Cafeteria	15k - 30k	Various food (noodles, nasi padang, soto betawi, nasi goreng, soup, sate, etc.), there's also japanese food like sushi and bento
Prominence Canteen	15k - 35k	rice bowls/sets, various dishes, noodles, yogurt, smoothies, etc
Family Mart (Prominence)	15k - 20k	sandwiches, rice sets, fried snacks, onigiri, salad, RTG drinks, snacks, bread, etc
MOR (Prominence)	20k - 35k	rice sets, fried snacks, RTG drinks, burger, snacks, etc
BINUS	20k - 30k	A variety of food
IKEA	30k - 80k	Variety of meatbals, chicken and etc.

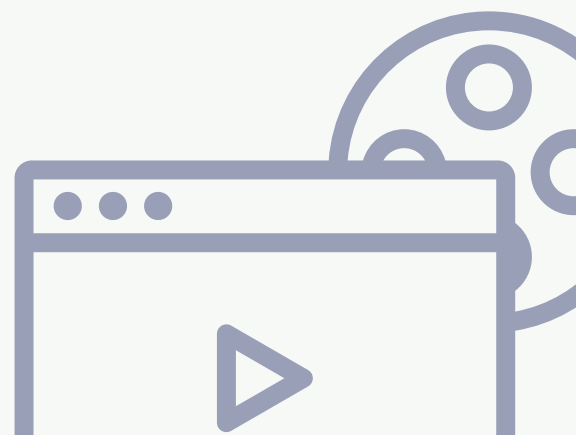

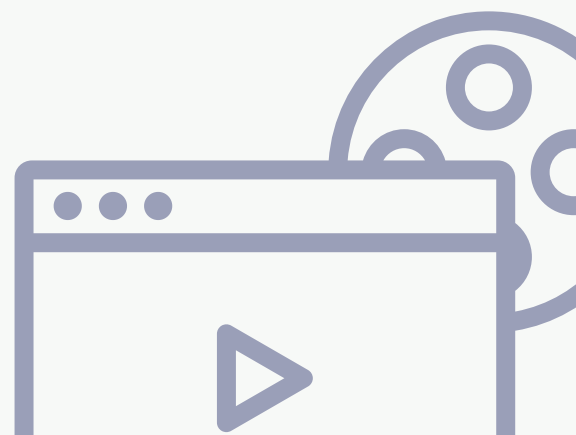

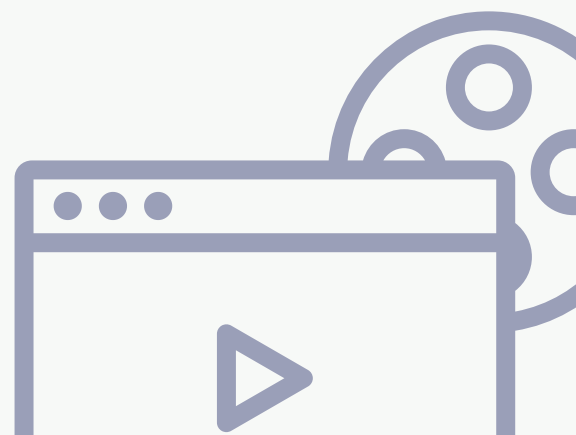
